Registration and cancellation policy

- All registration cancellations must be made in writing to Kiwanis International by letter, fax or e-mail.
- Registration cancellations received by **July 1, 2010**, will receive a full refund less a processing fee of US\$25. No refunds will be issued for registration cancellations received after **July 15, 2010**.
- Refunds will be issued after the close of the CKI convention.

Housing reservations

To get the most out of your convention experience, we suggest you arrive on **Wednesday, August 4**, and depart on **Sunday, August 8, 2010**.

All attendees are required to stay in Washington University in St. Louis housing. All housing fees are included in the event package fee and reservations must be made through CKI by using this form. Credit card payment will appear on your statement as a charge from Kiwanis International.

- Washington University in St. Louis will not accept any housing reservations.
- Up to four people of the same gender may share a suite.
- Roommates should arrive and depart on the same day.
- CKI will match roommates if necessary.

Housing cannot be guaranteed if this form is received after **July 1, 2010**.

Washington University in St. Louis residence hall policies

- All districts are assigned to the Washington University in St. Louis housing. Attendees are responsible for paying for their own charges outside the event package.
- The event package rate includes registration, housing, bed and bath linens, Internet (with guest providing Ethernet cable) and a campus card for meals. Washington University in St. Louis is providing linens for attendees. If linens or campus cards are not returned, charges will be assessed and charged to the attendee.
- All attendees must abide by the Washington University in St. Louis rules and regulations including no cooking in attendee rooms, no candles and no smoking or tobacco use on campus.
- All residence halls are locked. Buildings and rooms are only accessible with a campus key card.
