ROLE OF A PRESIDENT

- **Guide the club officers in setting goals**
 - Membership
 - Service Hours
 - Fundraiser

ROLE OF A PRESIDENT

- **Serve as the face of the club**
 - Be on the lookout for organization fairs
 - Send out emails to new and interested members
 - Be ready to talk about your club
 - Show excitement for your upcoming events

ROLE OF A PRESIDENT

- **Run club meetings**
 - Circle K 101
 - Programs about service projects
 - Ice breakers
 - Service projects
 - Member of the month
 - Updates on goals

ROLE OF A PRESIDENT

- **Club Social**
 - Holiday parties
 - Thanksgiving potluck
 - White elephant sock exchange
 - Bowling event
 - Get lunch/dinner before/after service projects

ROLE OF A PRESIDENT

- **Run board meetings**

ROLE OF A PRESIDENT
